




1.1 Age profile of active participants with an approved plan (no. of participants)




1.3 The level of function of active participants with an approved plan























5.1 Registered providers as at 31 March 2019 by entity type



3.2 Total annualised committed support for active participants with an approved plan by primary disability (%)




3.4 Total annualised committed support for active participants with a function score and an approved plan by level of function (%)














6.13 Distribution of active participants with an approved plan by level of function for age 7 to 14 yrs










6.19 Family/carers of participants 15 to 24


6.21 Distribution of active participants with an approved plan by level of function for age 15 to 24 yrs






6.29 Distribution of active participants with an approved plan by level of function for age 25+ yrs


