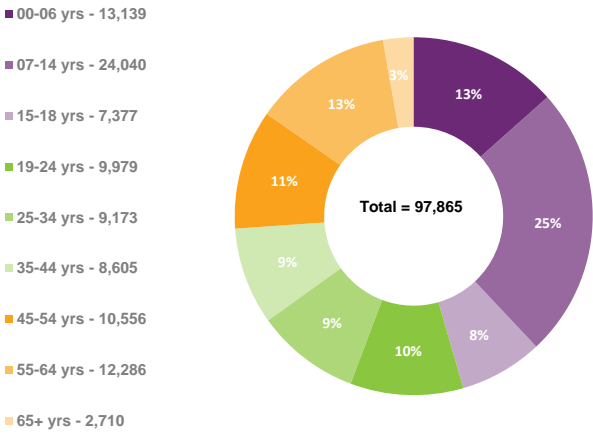
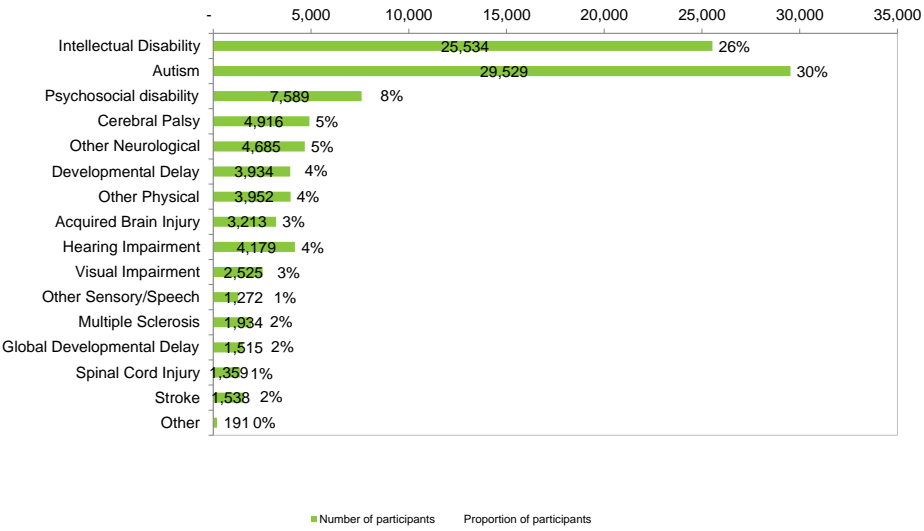

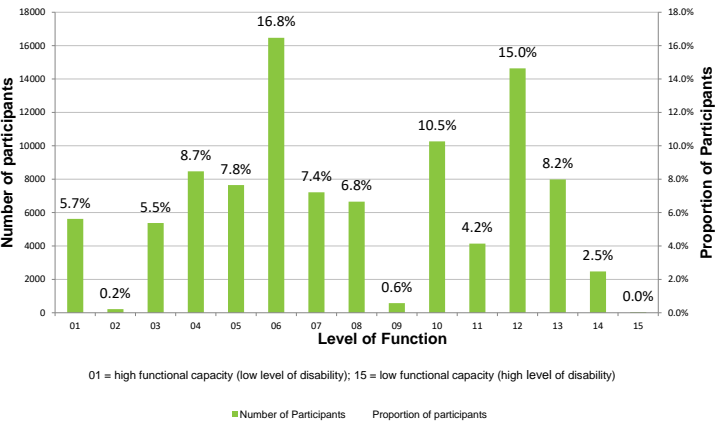
1.1 Age profile of active participants with an approved plan (no. of participants)



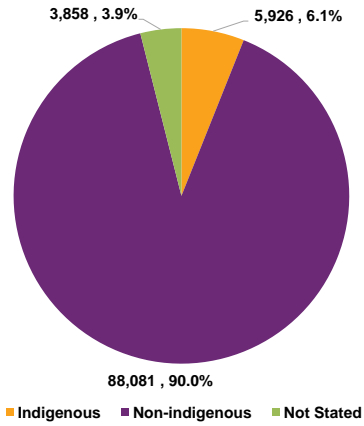
1.2 Primary disability of active participants with an approved plan



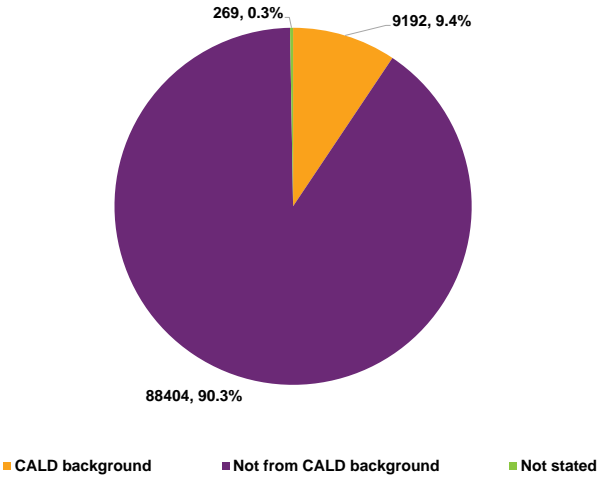
1.3 The level of function of active participants with an approved plan

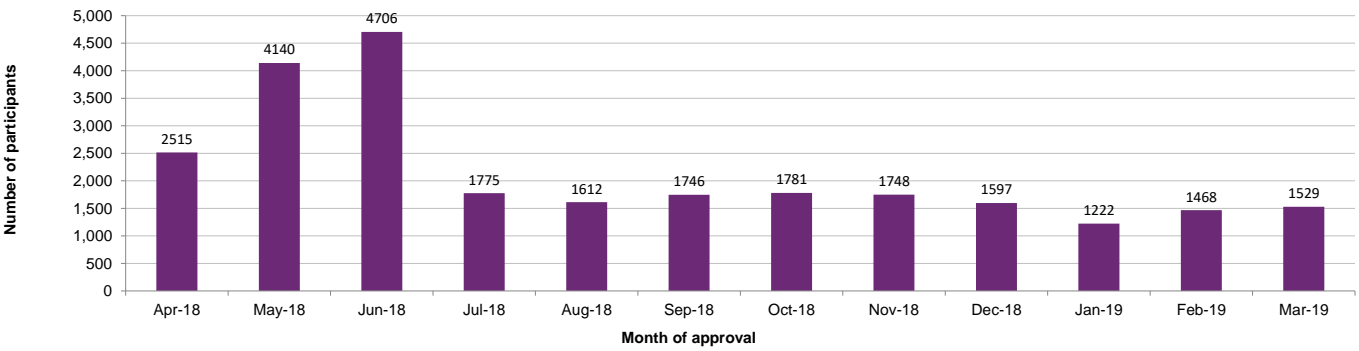

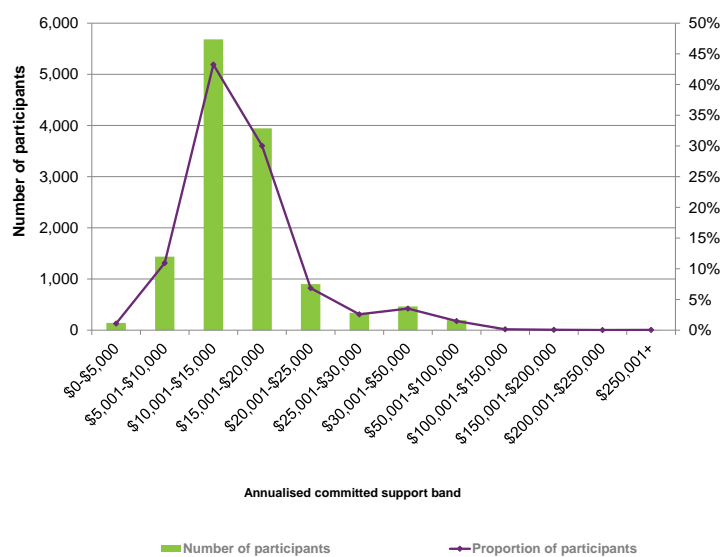

### 6.6 Distribution of active participants with an approved plan by primary disability for age 0 - 6 yrs



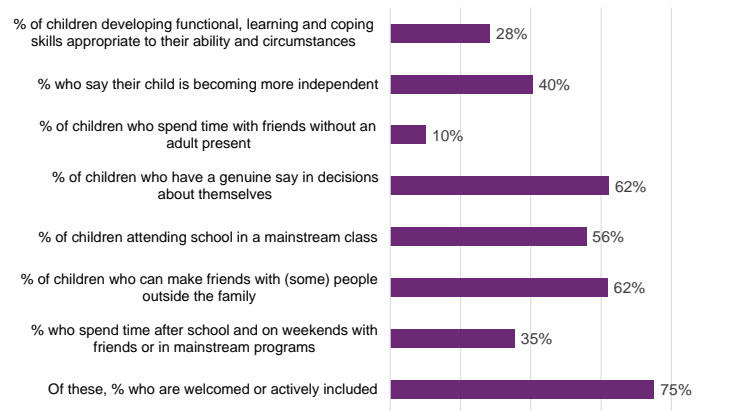

### 6.13 Distribution of active participants with an approved plan by level of function for age 7 to 14 yrs

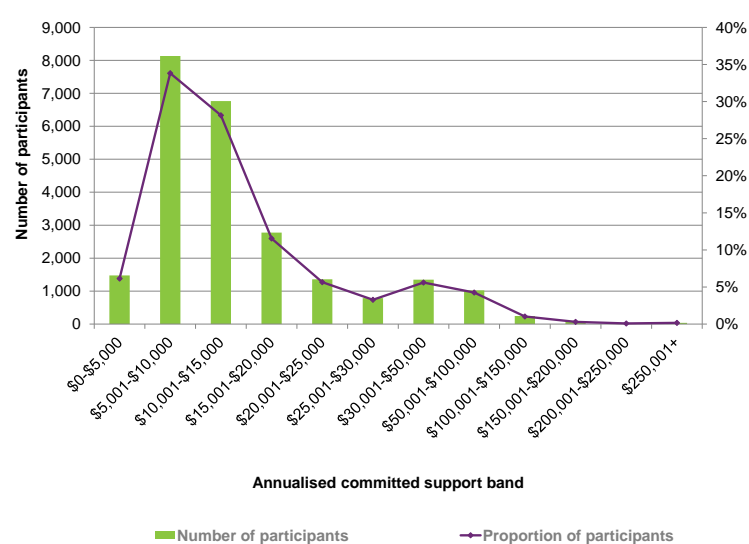


### 6.14 Distribution of active participants with an approved plan by primary disability for age 7 to 14 yrs

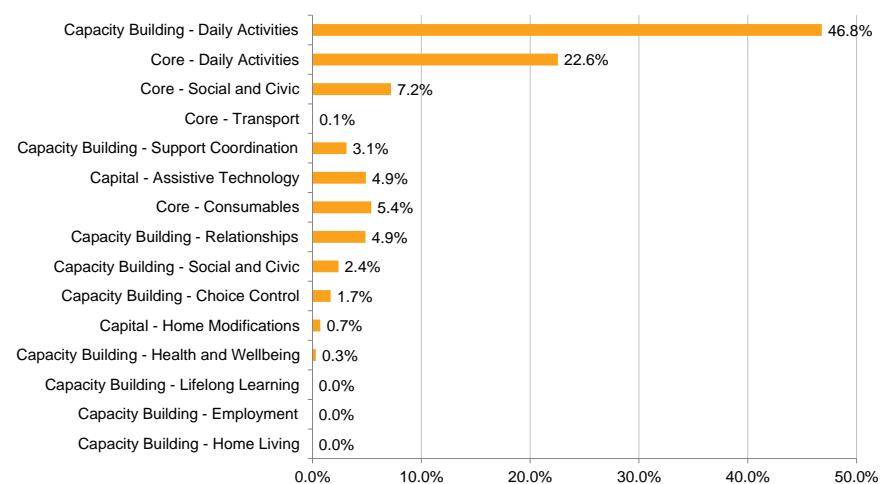

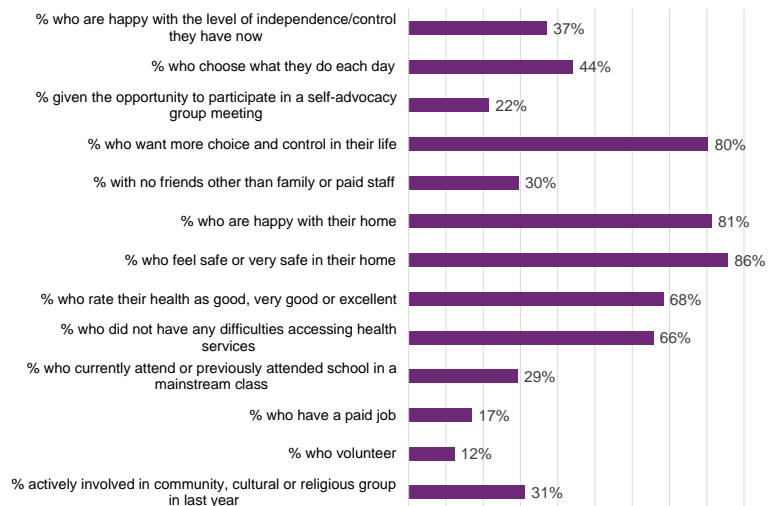

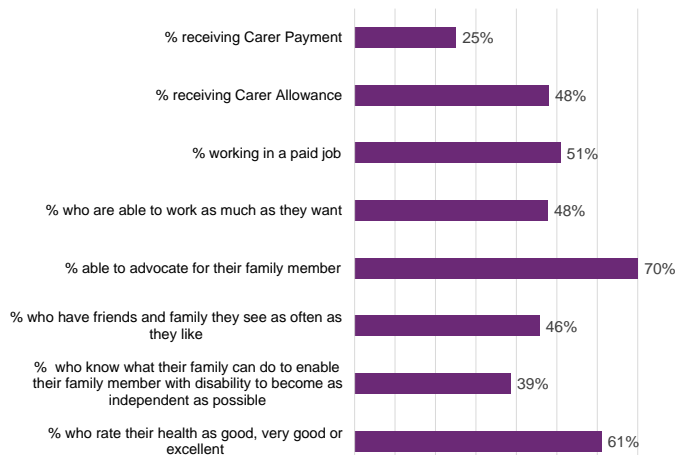

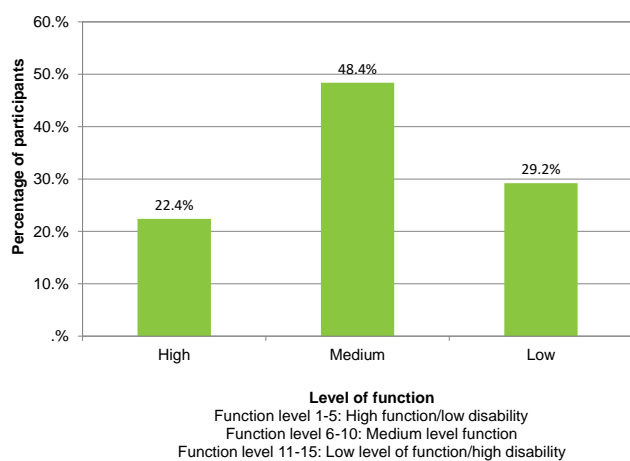

### 6.21 Distribution of active participants with an approved plan by level of function for age 15 to 24 yrs

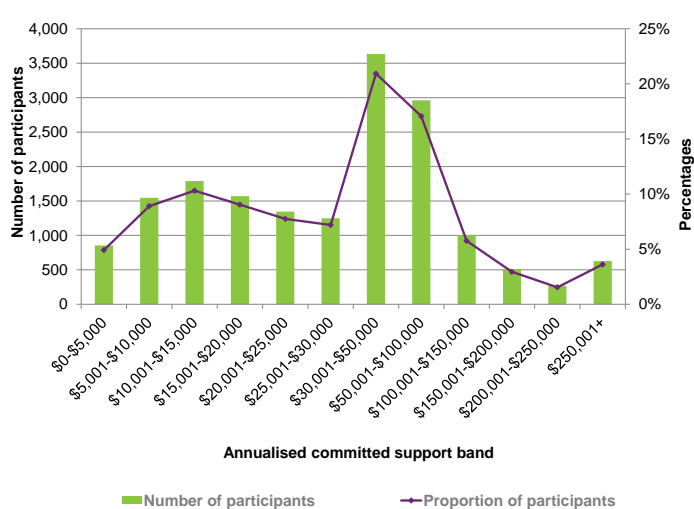


### 6.22 Distribution of active participants with an approved plan by primary disability for age 15 to 24 yrs

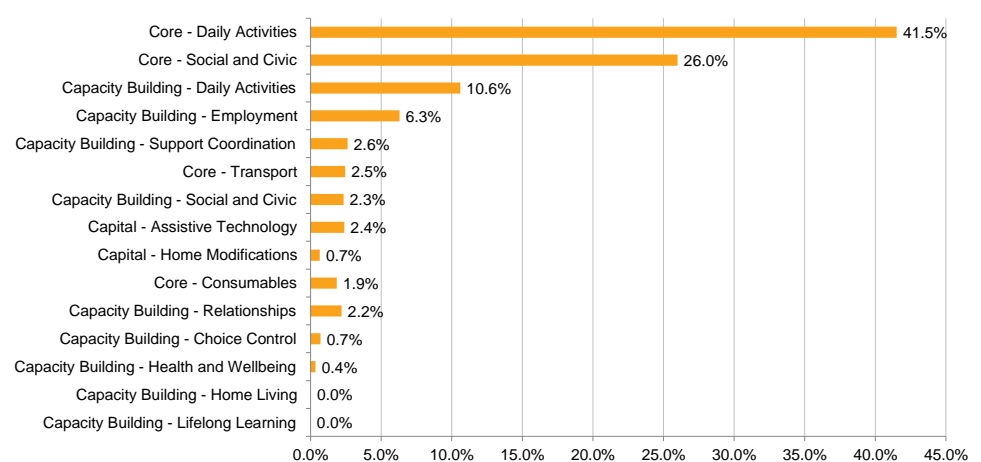

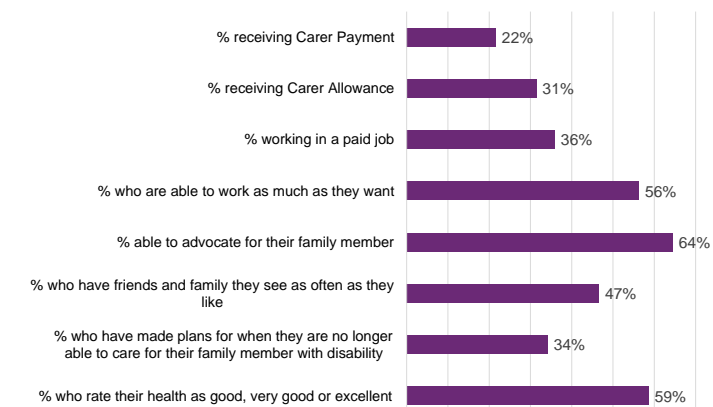

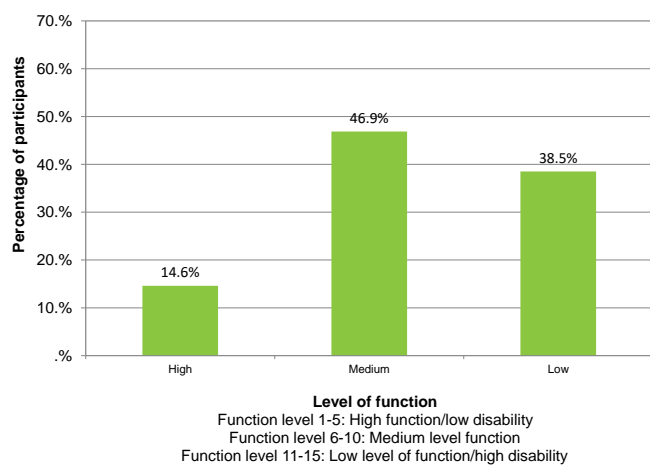

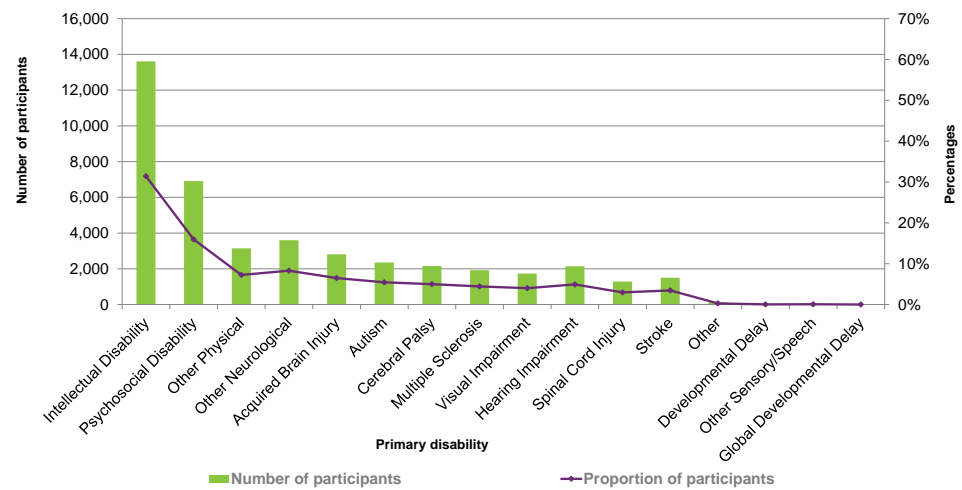

### 6.29 Distribution of active participants with an approved plan by level of function for age 25+ yrs

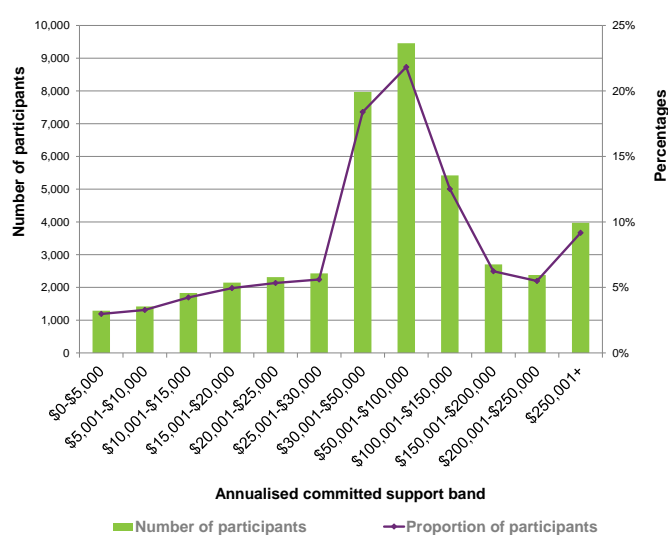


### 6.30 Distribution of active participants with an approved plan by primary disability for age 25+ yrs
