Student transport is an in-kind service

During the first few years of the NDIS, states and territories will continue to fund and provide student transport. If your state or territory has approved your access to student transport then you will continue to use this service. You don't need to use your NDIS plan funds to pay for it.

Student transport funds

Your state or territory government pays for student transport between home and school. You do not pay for this service out of your NDIS plan funds.

Student transport in a NDIS plan

The comments section of your plan will describe your pre-paid student transport supports.

When you see student transport support in your NDIS plan, it is only there to show you get the service.

Student transport providers

The provider for your state or territory student transport program will continue to deliver this service to you.
