#### Managing Josh's plan

Seven year old Josh from Freeling was one of the first South Australians to join the NDIS in July 2013.

Prior to joining the NDIS, the Mason family was "spiralling down physically, emotionally and financially" trying to pay for Josh's therapies to help him with his cerebral palsy and autism.

Josh's parents now self-manage Josh's NDIS plan and are able to alter his supports in response to his needs at any particular time. When Josh is progressing well physically,

they focus more on his autism through speech therapy and psychology, whilst at other times he requires more assistance with his mobility, so his parents redirect his funds to physiotherapy.
