


3.1 Total annualised committed supports for active participants with an approved plan by support category (%)




3.3 Total annualised committed supports for active participants with an approved plan by age group (%)








3.2 Total annualised committed supports for active participants with an approved plan by primary disability (%)




3.4 Total annualised committed supports for active participants with a function score and an approved plan by level of function (%)






4.4 Average annualised committed supports for active participants with a function score and an approved plan by level of function (\$)






6.5 Distribution of active participants with an approved plan by level of function for age 0 - 6 yrs



6.6 Distribution of active participants with an approved plan by primary disability for age 0 - 6 yrs






6.16 Total annualised committed supports for active participants with an approved plan by support category for age 7 to 14 yrs










6.22 Distribution of active participants with an approved plan by primary disability for age 15 to 24 yrs





6.27 Family/carers of participants age 25+ (selected indicators)




6.29 Distribution of active participants with an approved plan by level of function for age 25+ yrs





6.31 Distribution of active participants with an approved plan by annualised committed support band for age 25+




