University of Melbourne will co-design their housing roadmap with NDIS participants with multiple and complex support needs, in partnership with

1. Deafblind Australia, and
2. CHARGE Syndrome Australasia.

University of Melbourne will use the Individualised Supported Living (ISL) Framework to develop, test, and deliver an online education support package using co-design principles inclusive of people with disability and their families.

The online educational package aims to support families with adult children to:

1. increase knowledge and navigate the tools provided to review and discuss current and future living arrangements
2. identify suitable living arrangements
3. navigate practical steps in establishing and maintaining a suitable home and living option
