What the specialist disability accommodation (SDA) demand data is

Specialist disability accommodation (SDA) demand data is information that shows the amount of SDA-eligible participants across states and territories.

The demand data measures the amount of eligible participants who:

- are living in SDA
- have SDA funding and are looking for suitable SDA
- are seeking other options to SDA
- have completed the SDA housing assessment and are awaiting SDA funding in their plan.

What specialist disability accommodation (SDA) demand data is for

SDA demand data highlights information about the potential need for SDA across different regions.

How it helps providers

It is a helpful tool for you to find out where there may be a need for SDA.

It helps understand the amount of SDA-eligible participants that have access to funding, and participants who are currently in SDA.

The data also breaks down the number of participants who are SDA-eligible, but not using their funding.

The data can be shown by state or territory. It can also be viewed by [SA3 geographic area](#) where most people live and work.

The SDA demand data is updated 4 times a year.
