A Victorian man has been arrested after he allegedly defrauded the NDIS of around \$700,000 over a two-year period.

A joint investigation by the National Disability Insurance Agency (NDIA) and Victoria Police's Hamilton Crime Investigation Unit commenced after a man allegedly defrauded his own NDIS plan between 28 June 2024 and 30 June 2026.

Investigators allege the man established two businesses for the purpose of defrauding the NDIS.

It's alleged the man submitted false invoices for services he claimed to receive and distributed the funds into his bank accounts.

Detectives will also allege that the man dealt with property reasonably suspected of being proceeds of crime.

Yesterday, a search warrant was executed at a residential property in the Horsham area, and a 48-year-old man was taken into custody.

He will be interviewed in relation to the incidents.
