Current Council members Sylvana Mahmic, Liz Reid, Kerry Allan-Zinner, Judy Huett, Jennifer Cullen, Leah van Poppel and James Manders were reappointed for another term, along with Dr Ben Gauntlett as Expert Adviser, and joined by new members Tricia Malowney OAM, Sam Paior, Mark Tonga and Sharon Boyce.

The IAC provides formal advice to the NDIA Board, the governing body of the NDIS, on the most important issues affecting participants, carers and families. Decisions to appoint or re-appoint members were made in consultation with the NDIA, the current Principal Member of the Council, and states and territories.
