Indigenous Australian Government Development Program (IAGDP)

The [Indigenous Australian Government Development Program \(IAGDP\)](#) is a 15-month entry level program, run by the [Department of Education, Skills and Employment](#).

The program combines ongoing employment with structured learning. It leads to a Diploma of Government.

We are one of many Australian Public Service (APS) agencies taking part in the IAGDP.

If you're interested in working in the APS and the NDIA, there are a number of benefits.

These include:

- A permanent, full time position. You'll start at APS 3 level and move up to APS 4 when you complete the program
- Study at a Diploma level, with a range of specialisations offered
- Workplace and personal support from the IAGDP team and trainers
- Peer support, mentoring and coaching
- Competitive salary, superannuation and working conditions.
