## Australian Government flood support

You can access Australian Government support if you have been impacted by the recent flooding and severe weather.

- The Australian Government has activated support for communities impacted by the current flooding event in Queensland and NSW. [The Australian Government Disaster Recovery Payment is a one-off payment](#) available to those who have been significantly affected by a major disaster.
- [Recovery Connect](#) provides information on flood services and support such as food and essential services, health services and evacuation and recovery centres based on your location. Recovery Connect also provides information on how to prepare for a flood and what to do during flooding.
- [Services Australia](#) provides ongoing support to those who have been impacted by natural disasters by providing access to services such as financial help, living arrangements, family and domestic violence, social worker support and mental health help. Lump sum payments and short-term allowances have been made available to those who have been impacted by the recent [Queensland](#) and [NSW](#) flooding.
